Operation Safe Driver Week: July 11-17 Emphasis on speeding and unsafe driving

Operation Safe Driver Week has been scheduled for July 11-17 by the Commercial Vehicle Safety Alliance. During this week-long event, law enforcement officers will target commercial and passenger vehicles who are speeding or exhibiting other unsafe driving behaviors, such as reckless or aggressive driving, distracted driving, following too closely, improper lane change, failure to obey traffic control devices, failure to use a seat belt, evidence of drunk or drugged driving, etc. Identified unsafe drivers will be pulled over and issued a citation or warning.

We understand that CDL Drivers are under pressure for on-time deliveries, but please remember that when vehicles are traveling faster, the accidents they are in are likely going to be more severe! Please be cognizant of your speed, road signs, traffic signals and other drivers at all times.

Don't forget: Mapleton Ag offers a **\$100 bonus** for all drivers who don't exceed 15 MPH over the speed limit each month! Avoid a ticket *and* receive extra money in your pocket, just for maintaining a safe speed!
